## Extraordinary Person of the Week

Astronaut and chemist (May 30, 1963 – present)

In 1991, Helen Sharman became the first British Astronaut. Having received a BSc in Chemistry at University and then a PhD she worked as a chemist until one day she responded to a radio advertisement asking for volunteers to be the first British Astronaut. Out of 13,000 applicants, Sharman was selected and was just 27 years old when she went into space to visit Mir space station – making her the sixth youngest out of the 556 people who have visited space.

Before entering any part of the school building please read the questions below:

In the last 10 days have you or any member of your household tested positive for Covid-19?

In the last 10 days have you or any member of your household displayed symptoms of Covid-19?
High temperature
New continuous cough
Loss of, or change to, your sense of taste/smell

Have you been identified by test and trace, or any other official source, as a 'close contact' of someone who has tested positive for Covid-19, within the last 10 days?

If you have answered yes to any of the above, please DO NOT enter the school building.

Cheshire East have requested we share the information below with families:

- Please continue to communicate with your parents and staff the range of testing options available to them.
- Please continue to reiterate that anyone with a positive test (LFT or PCR) should isolate along with their household for the full 10 days.
- Please remind staff, pupils and parents that a negative LFT does not over-ride the need to stay at home and isolate if identified as a contact.

#### PCR tests for those without symptoms at Local Testing Sites (LTS')

Crewe and Macclesfield are two of our largest hotspots in terms of cases and so both our LTS' are now offering asymptomatic PCR testing daily between 0800 – 2000:

#### Chester Street Car Park, Crewe, CW1 2ER

- Opening hours 0800 2000
- Walk in
- On Portal (book appointment through national website https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test )

#### Commercial Road, Macclesfield, SK10 1GA

- Opening hours 0800 2000
- Walk in

Residents are offered a PCR test and then given several lateral flow tests to take home.

#### PCR tests for those without symptoms at Mobile Testing Units (MTUs)

It can be difficult to find suitable mobile testing site locations in Cheshire East as there is a specific national criteria, and often hesitancy from local residents despite this being for people with no symptoms, so our strategy is to provide a range of locations for our MTUs. The following sites are either live or will go live this week:

- Asymptomatic Testing

#### COVID-19 CLOSE CONTACT

A contact is defined as a person who has had contact (see below) at any time from **two days** before onset of symptoms (or time of test if asymptomatic) to 10 days after onset of symptoms (or test):

a person who has had face-to-face contact (within one metre) with someone who has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), including:

being coughed on, or

having a face-to-face conversation, or

having skin-to-skin physical contact, or

any contact within one metre for one minute or longer without face-to-face contact

- a person who has been within 2 metres of someone who has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) for more than 15 minutes
- a person who has travelled in a small vehicle *with* someone who has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) or in a large vehicle *near* someone who has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19)

people who spend significant time in the same household as a person who has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19)
