

The next day I went to see some pigs. I saw a pig and a stick house. "Come out little pig or I'll blow the house down," I said.



"Never," said the pig.

"I never warned no you," I said so I went out







I hugged and I puffed and I blow

again again.




Two day later I went out to find

Elves and the Shoe maker


Long ago in a Shoe Shop there lived a shoe maker and his wife. He was very poor until.... They had a visit from some elves.


This story is about me and my brother and we took a made a visit to a Shoe Shop and it changed everything.

Now time for the bad news. This is the real reason we went to the Shoe Shop. The Shoe maker was poor and his shoes where very bad so we helped.






This is the real Story . . .

One day they had enough money to buy enough leather to make a few pair of shoes. He got them ready to sell in the morning.


That's when we come in. We were just taking a stroll through the village and we saw the shoes. So we went back got our kit and got to work.

The shoe maker and his wife moved into a new and bigger house. One night the old shoe maker left some leather out. He came at mid-night to see what it was.




He waited until the clock struck

and left.


The Shoe maker realised they were
