### **Indoor Athletics**

On Wednesday afternoon an excited group of 24 children left school on a mini bus to attend the cluster Indoor Athletics tournament.

The children took part in field and track events. The afternoon started with the boys' then the girls' obstacle relay race. The boys and girls then alternated with field and track events. First up in running were the boys with 1x1 (one lap each of the hall) and the 2x2 (two laps) races for boys while the girls took part in the field events which included: chest push, vertical jump, speed bounce, standing long jump and standing triple jump. They then swapped over with this rotation happening 3 times. The races however changed to hurdles and 6 paarluf (6 laps of the hall). The final race was the 4 x 1 relay and this proved to be a most exciting race with the boys coming in a very close second.

Javelin was the last event of the afternoon and as always has the spectators full of laughter, cheers and moans. Fraser made the whole hall erupt with mirth when his foam javelin bounced off a side judge and landed back in play. The judge was fine!

Everyone had the opportunity to participate in two field and two track events. It was a loud and busy afternoon filled with excitement. The parents joined in enthusiastically and it was great having their support.

Goostrey was placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the event missing out on 3<sup>rd</sup> place by 3 points. Well done all and thank you for representing our school so well! It was a pleasure to spend the afternoon with you all.

### TAKING CHILDREN ON HOLIDAY DURING TERM TIME

## A guide for parents and carers

Frequently asked questions

Am I entitled to take my child out of school for a family holiday?
□ No. Parents have a legal duty to ensure that their children attend school or the alternative provision on a regular basis
☐ The Education Act 1996 makes it a criminal offence for a parent to "fail to secure their child's regular attendance at the school"
□ The amendments to the 2006 Regulations remove any reference to <i>family holidays</i> , <i>extended</i> leave and the statutory threshold of ten school days.
☐ The amendments make clear that <b>Head Teachers may not grant any leave of absence</b> (holiday) during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances
☐ The amendments give <b>parents no entitlement</b> to take their child out of school for a holiday in term time
☐ The Head Teacher and Governing Body will determine what the exceptional circumstances are
If we decide to take a holiday during term time what should we do?
☐ The parent/carer with whom the child resides must apply in writing to the school ☐ The letter/application must explain the exceptional circumstance surrounding the request for the leave of absence
What will the school do then?
☐ The Head Teacher will determine whether the exceptional circumstance ruling applies, if not the application will be declined
<ul> <li>Only the Headteacher (or the Deputy) has the power to approve leave of absence applications. When making the decision the protocols and criteria laid down in the school's attendance policy must be followed.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Each academic year, schools inform parents/carers via a letter, newsletter or some other communication; that they may receive a Fixed Penalty Notice if their child has unauthorised absences in term time</li> </ul>
□ You will receive a written response from the Headteacher (or the Deputy) letting you know if your application has been approved
☐ If the holiday goes ahead after the application has been declined the absence will be recorded as unauthorised

If you want to enrol your child into SUPERKIDS, our after school club. then please ring the Superkids office on 0161 474 7743 or you can come to the Junior hall, between 3.30 and 6pm. This number can be used for registration details, bookings adding people to Vizilogger etc.
